

WORLD PITCH & PUTT TOUR CIRCUIT 2023

The WPPT is organized by World Pitch & Putt Tour S.L.

The WPPT has the collaboration of FIPPA, according to agreement between both parties and with the approval of the member of FIPPA where the competition is held.

RIGHT TO PLAY

All players with a valid license from an Association or Federation member of the FIPPA will have the right to play the WPPT test.

Each FIPPA member will be assigned a number of seats, according to FIPPA criteria.

The number of places to register for the competition will be 216 players, and will be broken down as follows:

- 202 places for FIPPA members.
- 14 places reserved by the WPPT with the consent of the local player association.

FIPPA members are encouraged to define their places based on their association's rankings or rankings from previous official competitions. It is also recommended that an effort be made to include players in the list of places in each association. It is recommended to make an effort to incorporate women players into the list of places for each association, as there is also a money prize for the best ranked woman.

Registration will open on 02/20/23 and close on 03/10/23. FIPPA members must submit the list of selected players to the WPPT before 03/13/23.

The entry list of players will be made official on 03/16/23.

In the event that a FIPPA member leaves places free, it will be the WPPT together with the FIPPA, who will be in charge of distributing them according to their own criteria, and will open a second round of registrations on 03/17/23, which will end on the day 03/28/23.

The final list of players will be made official on 03/30/23.

COMPETITION REGISTRATION

Registrations of players designated by each FIPPA member federation or association will be made on the website www.worldpitchandputttour.com and payment will be made by transfer to the WPPT c / c in the time and manner indicated. In order to complete the registration, you will need to fill out a form and express acceptance of the regulations and rules of both the FIPPA and the WPPT.

The registration fee will be € XX and players will receive a separate right to play:

- 1 official gift from the WPPT circuit.
- Accreditation for the VIP PLAYER area, where breakfast and lunch on Thursday, Friday or Saturday (day of play)
- Accreditation for the VIP PLAYER area, for the cocktail on Sunday during the awards ceremony

GAME FORMAT

The players will play 36 holes according to individual stroke play mode and at the end of the two days, a cut will be made where the best 198 results will qualify to play on Sunday at the P&P Lleida.

The tie will be determined by the best last 18 holes, if the tie still persists, the tie will be determined by the formula of the 9, 12, 15, 17 and 18 best last holes, if the tie still persists, the tie will be determined for the last best hole, last two best holes, and so on up to the last 36 holes.

In the case of identical cards, all those players for whom the tie cannot be determined will qualify to play on Sunday. The last holes referred to in this paragraph are the last holes of the course, regardless of the starting tee of the players. On Sunday the best 198 results will be played 18 holes according to the individual stroke play modality.

GAME RULES

It will be played under current FIPPA rules, currently approved on April 1, 2020

SCHEDULE

The departure time will be made by the WPPT trying to maintain the preferences of the players. The competition will be played over 4 days: Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Each player will play 36 holes spread over 2 rounds, the first will be played on Thursday, Friday or Saturday, depending on the day of play, unless the Competition Committee decides to modify it for exceptional reasons.

The first departure on Thursday, Friday and Saturday will be at 10:00 a.m. and the second departure will be at 3:00 p.m.

On Sunday the players will play 18 holes according to the individual stroke play modality.

Between the first and the second outing, the players will have a minimum of two hours to be able to change venues and eat. The players will have the right to eat on the field where they will play their second round of the day.

The first start on Sunday will be at 9:00 a.m., the second start will be at 12:00 a.m. and the last third will be at 3:00 p.m.

The 2 groups with the best ranked players will start with a margin of 6 minutes, from the 1st tee.

PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Players with a place for the WPPT will be able to practice with a special price from March 30 until the day before the tournament beginning, under the following conditions:

From Monday to Friday: Green fee (18 holes) €10 / Unlimited daily green fee €15

From weekends and Holidays: Green fee (18 holes) €15 / Unlimited daily green fee €20

Unlimited green fee €80

On Thursday, Friday and Saturday, 72 participants will play 36 stroke play holes, spread over 2 rounds of 18 holes.

First departure: 10:00 a.m.

Second departure: 3:00 p.m.

Sunday will play the 198-best classified, 18 holes stroke play
Departure of players classified from position 127 to 198: 9.00 a.m.
Departure of players classified from position 55 to 126: 12.00 a.m.
Departure of players classified from position 1 to 54: 3:00 p.m.

The WPPT will put lunch competition days between 8:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
The WPPT will offer players a buffet for lunch on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, which will be open from 1:15 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.
On Sunday at 6:00 p.m., the awards ceremony will be held, followed by a cocktail for the players.
Players will have water and fruit throughout the tournament.

The prizes that WPPT will award before taxes and withholdings will be as follows:

Women's Trophy for the best ranked player € 500

In the event that the winner of the women's trophy or the winner of the senior trophy is also awarded in the absolute classification, she will be given the highest cash prize, but the trophy will be maintained as the champion.
The amount of the lowest cash prize will be given to the next qualifier in the corresponding category.

TIEBREAK

In the event of a tie for the place of champion in any category, the tied players will play hole by hole to "sudden death" until the tiebreaker, starting with the hole determined by the Competition Committee, and following the order of designated holes.
In the event of a tie for any other place with a prize, the sum of the prize money of the positions will be made and divided equally between the players tied in the same position.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The Organizing Committee will be composed of members of the WPPT.
The suspension of the test prior to the event is the responsibility of this committee.

COMPETITION COMMITTEE

It will be formed by WPPT members.
The Competition Committee may, due to weather or major forces, redefine the competition.
The suspension of the test during its holding is the responsibility of this committee.
The minimum number of holes to play for prize giving will be 36 holes.
